Language Production (Speaking and writing)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Form simple statements with information including the negative• Recognise, repeat and adapt phrases from rhymes and songs• Listen and repeat key phonemes with care• Select and write simple words and short phrases, some from memory• Use different adjectives with a singular noun, with correct positioning and agreement.
Cultural Awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• know that in French there are formal and informal greetings• know the names and locations of some of the cities in France• know that the currency used in France is euros and to recognise some of the notes and coins
